- 3) MAKE A SLIDE SHOW OR POWERPOINT OF YOUR PROJECT (examples on the blog)
- 4) PRESENT YOUR PROJECT IN CLASS INA 3-5 MINUTE SPEECH
- 5) WRITE THE CARTEL FOR THE EXHIBITION
